NATIONALS!







The YMCA Gymnastics National Competition was held in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania from June 21–24, 2024. Lancaster YMCA sent 38 female athletes ranging from levels 2–9. We also had 2 male athletes competing in the Boy's Division for the first time in our program's history. There were more than 2,000 competitors from over 70 YMCA teams throughout the nation for this event. Notable individual accomplishments were Scarlette Dille (level 4) and Harper Spires (Xcel Platinum level) winning the floor exercise for their levels. Isabelle Capsel, Zoe DeLeon, Sydnie Metz (Xcel Platinum level), and Halle Spires (level 8) all qualified for a second day of competition for all around finals. Sam Pennington (level 9) also made program history by being the first gymnast in a championship level to make an event final, which was on beam. As a team, our Xcel Platinums placed 4th and our level 9s placed 6th in the country. Many of our other gymnasts earned podium finishes throughout the competition. 


As for July, go out to the band stand on Friday

Also don't forget the 4th of July Parade! Let's all celebrate our freedom and who sacrificed for us to have it. God Bless America!


